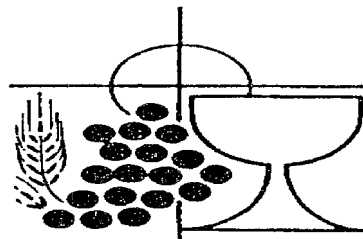

The Timeless Message of Jesus Then and Now

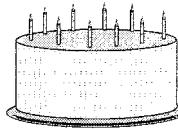
