*From Sr. Joann:* You will notice by the vestments worn by Fr. Kevin that we are back in Ordinary Time. ("Ordinary" meaning ordered rather than normal.) We will continue to be in "Ordered Time" until the Season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on February 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Our Parish Core Team (Jerry Marchlewicz, Nancy Cusick, Rick Jankowiak and Diane Middleton) will be overseeing the evaluation of parish ministries based on the Criteria given to us by the Diocese. It is important that we do this with honesty, recognizing our strengths and also the areas in which more effort needs to be placed. The Criteria are divided into four categories: Sacramental Life of the Parish; Evangelization, Catechesis, Catholic Schools and Lifelong Religious Formation; Stewardship and Justice; and Effective Administration. In order to collect the broadest response from parishioners the Leadership Council and parish commissions are now addressing questions given to us as part of a survey. That survey (long form) is available on line at the Diocesan website. ([www.saginaw.org](http://www.saginaw.org)). We are looking into the possibility of completing the survey on the St. Hedwig website. Later a shorter version of the survey will be mailed to every household. We will also be referring to the results given us for the McCarthy Report on the state of the parish that was done in 2007. Additional information will be coming in the following weeks as we attempt to keep you informed. Please, please keep this undertaking in your daily prayers.
