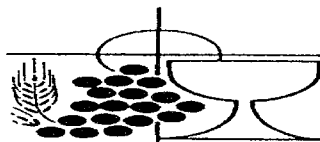

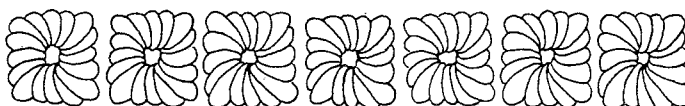

From Sr. Joann, The Greek word for Pentecost means "fiftieth," and in early Christianity it referred to the entire Fifty Days of Easter. The roots of Pentecost can be found in the Jewish festival of Weeks (Shavu'ot), the 50-day Thanksgiving celebration following Passover. Early Christians reinterpreted the Jewish festival as a commemoration of the coming of the Holy Spirit, since Acts records that the Holy Spirit came to the disciples when the festival of Pentecost was fulfilled. In the coming week let us each day keep this spirit of thankfulness very alive in our thoughts, words and actions.

Every year at the May meeting of the Leadership Council members take time to tour our buildings and grounds taking special note of new items needing maintenance either now or in the future. One such item that has been on the list for a couple of years and will soon be addressed is the updating of the landscaping under the bell tower.
