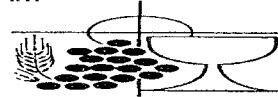

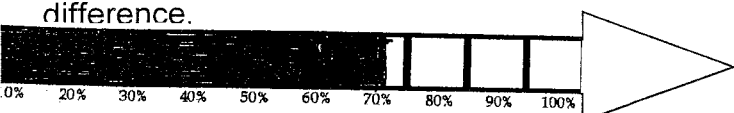
New Members
